



Lunch Program

Hope Academy has worked with Hurley's Supermarket to provide hot lunch for our students since 2014. Each month, the menu is sent to parents and students pre-order their selection. Students are offered three choices each day: two hot options and a California roll. The cost for Hurley's lunch is C1\$6 and includes fruit and juice/water.

The individually wrapped lunches are collected by school staff and brought to the students to eat at school. Prior to Covid-19 restrictions, primary students ate together in the Hall; currently, students eat in their classrooms.

Students also have the option of ordering from Papa John's. These orders must be placed in advance at the front desk each morning and are also brought to the school for students.

Students may also bring lunch from home. Unfortunately, due to space restrictions, we are unable to microwave meals at lunch. We request that parents do not send in any items that need heating.

Please note:

- We are a peanut free school.
- Soda is only allowed for High School students at lunch time or during extended breaks. Glass bottles are not allowed in the school building.

While they may also order from the Hurley's menu, High School students (Grades 9-12) are allowed to go to Hurley's during break and lunch; they are also allowed to walk to Burger King or order from Papa John's during lunch. Pre-Covid, students in Grades 11 and 12 were permitted to leave campus at lunch. The procedures and privileges will be outlined at the beginning of the school year, taking into account any current Public Health requirements. Permission forms must be completed by parents each year to give them permission to go to Hurley's and/or leave campus. These are also privileges that may be revoked if students do not follow the safety guidelines required or are habitually late returning to school. At no time are students allowed to be in the prohibited sections of the campus or to be hanging out in the parking lot around the cars.
